# Choices

At Threshold we currently have a Choices programme, which is being accredited through the Respect accreditation process. Our Choices programme aims to help those who commit domestic abuse to understand their behaviours and change them. Here is a mini case study of one attendee of the programme. For confidentiality purposes we have changed his name to Kai:

"Kai was referred to Choices by Social Services earlier this year. He was happy to try the course. Although at first he was nervous, Kai became to engage with the group. Kai had struggled with physically assaulting his partner, using drugs and overconsuming alcohol. Although Kai said he knew his behaviour was wrong he was unsure how to change it.

22 group sessions later and Kai says he now realises what he was like and can now spot problems before they arise. He now has conversations with his partner to check things are okay and that he is more laid back now. Before, Kai hated to lose an argument with his partner now he lets things go and agrees to disagree."

Choices has impacted Kai's life in a big way – maybe it can do the same for you too.
