

Project Y



In the past few weeks our brand new program has started – Project Y.

The **Project Y** program will support young people at a very early stage, where possible to sit down and talk through with the help of mediation; problems and issues around the breakdown of the relationship, residency of the children, access and the rights of the children to see both parents if they wish to do so.

The project delivery will be split into a number of programs such as

The Sparrow Program – a bespoke program written for delivering to children and young people (age 8 – 25) about healthy relationships, covering areas such as; social media, sexting, safe use of the internet, sexual health, understanding sexual orientation, suicide intervention, drug and alcohol abuse, mental health, self-harming, bullying, peer pressure, healthy relationships and healthy eating

Purple Heart – RESPECT young person program – an early intervention program focussing on teenage use of violence in close relationships (boyfriends, girlfriends, siblings, anyone with whom young people share a relationship with).

Making waves – is a parental abuse program (10 - 25) for those who have been violent to a family member including parents, siblings etc.

Open 4 All – mediation program working with the whole family. A specialist service developed for young people, taking into account their specific needs. The program is flexible, sensitive and individualised, paying great attention to young people's personal needs

Only Health Care and Legal Professionals Aloud – training for Health Care professionals and the legal profession and the WISH Program provided accredited programs of support for those 16+

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
